ENTRIES: The enclosed Entry, Medical & Timing slip and must be completed and returned with the entry or you must register online. Online registrants are confirmed once their check is received. Online registration is available by going to the NESSCA, NER or Mo-Hud websites. A \$50 late entry fee will be charged for entries not received by 6/12/04. A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned checks. Phone entries are not accepted. Make Checks payable to **Mohud, SCCA. Send entry to:**

A valid SCCA Novice Permit is required.

CANCELLATIONS: The organizers reserve the right to cancel/postpone the event should circumstances beyond their control develop. When possible, all entrants will receive advance notice of such action with advice on refund arrangements. Drivers: All cancellations/withdrawals must be made in writing and postmarked no later than 10 days after the event. Any car that puts a wheel on the course is not eligible for a refund.

CREDENTIALS: Drivers, Crew & Workers will be issued credentials at registration. Lost Credentials cannot be replaced. All participants (except those with temporary memberships) must wear their SCCA photo ID at all times. Photo IDs are available at registration. Entry fee includes cost of credentials for driver and three crewmembers. Credentials for additional over crew may be purchased from Lime Rock Park personnel at registration. Drivers are responsible for notifying their crew of the official hours of registration and are responsible for the behavior and actions of their crews at all times while at the event. Drivers and crewmembers not able to register during the posted times can gain access to the track by paying a non-refundable fee to the track and registering the next day during posted hours. This event is open to all holders of valid SCCA

NEW IN 2004: MINOR WAIVERS: The Minor Waiver can only be signed by the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and witnessed by a licensed Registrar or Steward OR notarized. Additionally, all previous "Permanent Minor Waivers" or "Waiver on File Ids" are void. A new Minor Waiver must be completed annually. IF a minor not your own will be accompanying you to the event and does not have access to this form, a .pdf version may be downloaded from www.scca.org (Insurance) and printed in color. Remember the signatures on that form MUST be witnessed by a Registrar or Steward OR notarized.

PADDOCK: All non-licensed paddock vehicles must be identifiable to an Entrant or Driver and may only be operated by a responsible adult for the purpose of race support. **NO SITTING OR RIDING ON THE EXTERIOR OF MOVING VEHICLES. Speed Limit in the Paddock is 5 MPH and ONE WAY SIGNS MUST BE OBEYED.** NO SKATEBOARDS ARE ALLOWED. Racing and Unleaded Fuel is available for sale in the west corner of B Paddock. Water and Air are available in A Paddock on the B Paddock side of the restaurant. ALL CANS AND BOTTLES MUST BE DEPOSITED FOR RECYCLING IN THE GREEN DRUMS, USED OIL MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN THE BLUE DRUMS AND ALL OTHER WASTE SHOULD BE PLACED IN RED DRUMS. **PLEASE TAKE YOUR USED TIRES HOME WITH YOU.**

Lime Rock Park has spent considerable expense and effort to make this a better facility for our use. The paving has been upgraded at considerable expense, treat it like you owned it. Do not drive stakes etc. into the pavement. It is your responsibility to follow these rules, remember Drivers are responsible for the actions of their Crew.

INJURIES: To be eligible for medical benefits from the insurer, any Driver or Crew who sustains and injury (no matter how small), must go to Race Medical and have a Green Card completed.

SOUND CONTROL: Sound Control will be effect per the GCR. **NO RACE ENGINES MAY BE STARTED BEFORE 10am** on Friday.(**except to go to Grid**) All Race engines must be off by **6pm**. **No race engines may be started at anytime on Thursday**

SCRUTINEERING: All cars must have passed an Annual Inspection. Scale Availability times will be posted.

CAR NUMBERS- All car numbers and class designations must be to GCR specifications. Any Non SCCA Sanctioning Body Logos or lettering, including class designations must be removed from the car or completely covered.

CONNECTICUT STATE LAWS: The DMV controls racing in CT. State law requires flat-towed cars to have a License Plate. State officials may require rain tires on racecars if it rains. The area around the track is under strict State Police supervision.

PITS/GRID: The working Pits/Grid are restricted to SCCA members who are at least 18 years of age or 16 years of age with "W" credentials issued by Topeka. Personnel in these areas must be properly attired (closed toe shoes, sleeved shirts and long pants. No halter tops).

Cars entering the Race Course (track) from Pit lane are to keep Drivers Right of the blend line painted on the track, drivers who fail to do this may be penalized.

DOGS - Lime Rock Park does not allow Pets.

Previous Racing Experience- Students with previous racing experience should document that racing experience and place it in their Novice Permit.

Worker Contributions- Contributions to the workers fund are greatly appreciated. You may just add any amount you wish to your check or make a separate donation at Registration. Mohawk Hudson Region matches all driver donations and distributes them via a raffle at the end of the day. Donors are recognized in our program unless anonymity is requested.
