Membership Meeting Minutes JUNE 2015

Meeting called to order 7:45 pm.

Secretary – May membership meeting minutes need one correction - roll bars do not need to be in cars for the Thompson drivers school. Revised minutes will be submitted to the Knock Off Editor.

Knock Off – members reminded to get their articles submitted in time. The 15th of each month is the deadline.

Treasurer – income/expenses reported for the previous month.

Solo – Russ provided a report on the recent solo event – there were 60 competitors on the Sunday race. Other news - possible new site may have been located. Russ will be taking a look at the venue.

Street Survival – still no confirmed date – the school will be held on one of the first two weekends of October. The Saratoga Museum will be partnering with us.

Rally – no report.

Time Trial – will be July 11th. Participants will have two 20 minutes sessions – entry fee is \$160. It will be held at Thompson in conjunction with the New England SCCA Regional Race. Registration opened on June 3.

Activities – Go Kart night will be on August 5 at the Funplex, \$22 for unlimited go kart rides; August 13, golf at Burden Lake, \$33, includes kart and buffet dinner.

Competition – two new Mo Hud drivers were signed off at the New Hampshire drivers school.

Membership – Jim Garry reported that we currently have 424 members with 9 new members in May. Member anniversaries were summarized.

Old Business – Guptills Car Show will be Monday evening, 5 pm to 9 pm, June 8th. Mo Hud will have a booth there. Members are welcome to stop by. We will be offering free entries for the Solo program as we did last year. Mo Hud van has been inspected for this year. We're still looking for a replacement van or small box truck. RPI Formula Race Team - Bruce and Eric met with the group last Wednesday and provided them with basic pointers on driving and car handling. Mini Con - Jim Garry is searching for an individual who can do a seminar on solo course design. He is also trying to arrange for a safety steward seminar as well as an SCCA Board Member who can provide an update on the future direction of Solo.

New Business – NARRC - there is a lack of available information about the need to have a new treasurer. Mo Hud needs more information before we can vote on a replacement treasurer. Dick Stewart suggested that the NARRC topic of treasurer position be included on the Mini Con agenda. Club logo merchandise - Eric will be putting information on facebook, the website, and in the Knock Off. Suggested that we upgrade radios to FRS. Radios with headphones would help. We should consider purchasing new radios. Need to test them first before purchasing to make certain that volume is loud enough to compete with engine noise. *Meeting adjourned at 9:10 pm.*

Membership Meeting Minutes JULY 2015

Meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm.

Secretary - June meeting minutes were not published in the Knock Off. Secretary will ask they be published in the next edition.

Membership - Eric read Jim's report. There are presently 424 members. New member's names were read to the membership. Significant member anniversaries were also read.

Knock Off – it was noted that Secretaries minutes and member anniversaries were not published in the June publication.

Treasurer - Todd summarized the previous month's income and expenses.

Solo - Solo event was held this past weekend. There were 44 entries. National Tour was at Devons last month. Four Mo Hud members competed. Results have not yet been posted. Russ has dropped a check to Fortitech. There has been no change in their position on the use of their site.

Tire Rack Street Survival - date has been confirmed for Saturday, Oct 10th. It will be held at the Saratoga Auto Museum. Instructors and volunteers will be needed. Attendance will be limited to 24 students. Tricia has flyers available - both print and by email. Please contact her for copies.

Rally - still in the planning stages. May be held this Fall.

Time Trial at Thompson - this will be an "intro to track day" at Thompson. Format is very similar to "Track Night in America". We currently have 7 paid entries.

Activities - Golf outing will be August 13, 2:00 pm, Burden Lake country club. No experience necessary. Kart Night will be at the Funplex on August 5th.

Competition - Jack provided a summary of the races at New Hampshire and the Glen.

Old Business - Eric described status of updating the bylaws. Jim Bucci laid out a couple of proposed changes - officer elections every two years rather than every one year. Also a possibility of term limits, e.g. two "two year terms" and then individual must vacate position. This would be similar to the Finger Lakes Region who holds election every two years with two year terms. An individual must not be in the position for one term in order to run for that office again. This would be limited to the specific office that the person holds. July 13th, Monday, is the next car show at Guptill's. This will be a Solo and Street Survival night. Eric and DJ will have their cars available. Mini Con - will be November 13th - 14th in Saratoga. Banquet will be at the Saratoga Auto Museum. Radios – there was a 50% failure rate at the last Solo event. We either need new batteries for the radios or need to purchase new radios. FRS radios may be an option, but they may not have a high enough volume to overcome the ambient noise.

New Business - next Mo Hud meeting will be at the Funplex on August 5th.
