An interesting view on SCCA history --- comment by your (Interm) Editor

As you'll note from both the minutes above, and press releases by the SCCA, there were co-champions named for this year's National Championship in the Spec Miata class.



Preston Pardus and Nicolas Bruni crossed the finish line literally side-by-side, as this photo shows. It would seem this was the correct call by race officials.

And while it was the closest finish ever in RunOffs history, it's no quite true that this was the first time there have been cochampions.

In 1964 the SCCA made a late decision to crown National Champions at the American Road Race of Champions held at Riverside Raceway in California.

However since this plan came after the season had started they also named National Champions under the old system of a multi-race format. So if you go back an look in the SCCA

record book for 1964 you'll see National co-champions named for multiple classes.



Selling my 2008 Civic Si sedan that I run in the Tuner 4 (T4) SCCA Time Trials class.



Purchased New and owned for 15 years. This car is my daily and track car and has 124,xxx miles on it (this will change as the car gets driven when I need to go in to the office)

The good:

- Redshift competition coilovers with 10k/20k Swift Springs. Plus another set of Redshifts in the box (revalved BC DS coilovers by Redshift). There is a wait time for these shocks but you'll have a spare set when you need to service the shocks. You could also sell the shocks if you don't need them.

- in 2019, the car was dropped off at Tailored Chassis Solutions and they went through the car replacing all bushings and refreshing all that's



needed. Have receipts and can share. Subsequently the car was tuned by Quantum in Selkirk and a Skunk2 CAI and header were added in addition to an Invidia Q300 and a tune.

- 124,xxx miles is low for an original owner car.

- Rust free given that this is a Northeast car. Has been garage parked for most of its life.

- Six sets of wheels including two OEM sets. One set of steelies with snow tires (to roll it around the shop), staggered set of Enkeis with RE71RS (17x8 245; 17x7 225), Tire Rack C3 wheels with Hankook RS4s, Motegi TrackLite wheels with 225-45-17 RT660s.

- Goodridge SS Brake lines installed this year



- New set of Rotors (front and rear) in box along with new Carbotech XP10 and XP8 brake pads
- Original floor mats unused and will be included.
- 8th Gen Civic Shop manuals
- Both keys plus valet key included
- KTuner will also come with the car.

The Rest:

- At some point the transmission will need an input shaft bearing to be replaced. On cold days there is a slight noise on cold starts that goes away as the car warms up. This has not been an issue with driveability and I have driven the car with no issues. One reason I'm selling is because I don't have the skill to undertake this and the only place in the Capital District I trust has closed shop (Quantum in Selkirk).

- AC Clutch may need to be replaced or the car might need a new AC compressor. AC works intermittently as of now.

- The car has had bumpers replaced after minor fender benders.
- It has some scuffs and tiny dents and comes with stickers because racecar





Combine the dramatic writing of BS Levy's Last Open Road series, such as *Montezuma's Ferrari*, with the accurate but expressive automobile illustrations found in Herge's TinTin books, and you get the impact of Michel Constant's graphic novel series featuring mechanic Mauro Caldi. *Mille Miglia*, sampled here, may be the best of the lot.


An Authentic Ferrari 250 GTO



This car started out as a 330 LM in 1962, reconfigured by Ferrari at the end of the year as a 250 GTO. Racing history includes Nuburgring and LeMans with drivers such as Lorenzo Bandini and Mike Parkes.

Created by using a 250 GTO with the chassis enlarged to accommodate a 4.0 liter V-12 for prototype racing, it was catalogued as a 330 GTO. Then, end-of-season work involved installation of *Colombo* 3.0 liter *168/62* engine and assuring that the car met 250 GTO-Group 3 GT homologation specs. (Cobra meat!)
